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POST-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. If you should experience excessive tearing, redness, swelling, pain or a decrease in vision, please call our office immediately whether during or after office hours.
- 2. There will be occasional discomfort after returning home from the hospital. Take two (2) tablets of Extra-Strength Tylenol for pain relief. If you suffer severe or deep pain, call our office.
- 3. An eye pad is not necessary, but if you have excessive discharge, one can be worn during sleep.
- 4. Do not try to hold back a cough or sneeze. If necessary, bend at the knees instead of stooping.
- 5. The eyelids may be gently cleansed using a Q-Tip or gauze pad moistened with water. DO NOT RUB YOUR EYE!
- 6. Use eye drops/medications as instructed along with your regular medications (if any).
- 7. Avoid activities which involve severe head movements or shaking.
- 8. Daily activities may be resumed upon instruction by your doctor.
- 9. Do not fly or lie flat on your back if a gas bubble has been placed in your eye.
- 10. Shake drops before using. Wait 5 minutes between drops.
- 11. If you call our office after hours or on the weekend with any problems, and do not get a response within 30 minutes, go directly to the nearest emergency room.

Detailed instructions will be given to you at your post-op appointment.
